Evita Lohu studied piano at the Kehtna School of Arts with Hele Saarse and at the Tallinn Music High School with Kersti Sumera. Currently she is a student of Mihkel Poll at the Estonian Academy of Music and Theatre. In 2018/19 she was an exchange student at the University of Music Franz Liszt Weimar, where she studied with Professor Grigory Gruzman. She has participated in master classes of renowned pianists such as Ivori Ilja, Gintaras Januševicius, Peep Lassmann, Niklas Pokki, Toomas Vana, Irina Zakharenkova and Andrius Žlabys.

As a soloist and chamber musician she has performed in notable venues in Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Germany, and Poland and has taken part in several piano and chamber music competitions. In 2019 she won Third Prize at the 9th Estonian Piano Competition (2019). In 2016 she made her orchestra debut in Riga, performing with a youth symphony orchestra. She has also performed with the symphony orchestras of the Tallinn Music High School and the Estonian Academy of Music and Theatre as well as with the Estonian National Symphony Orchestra.
